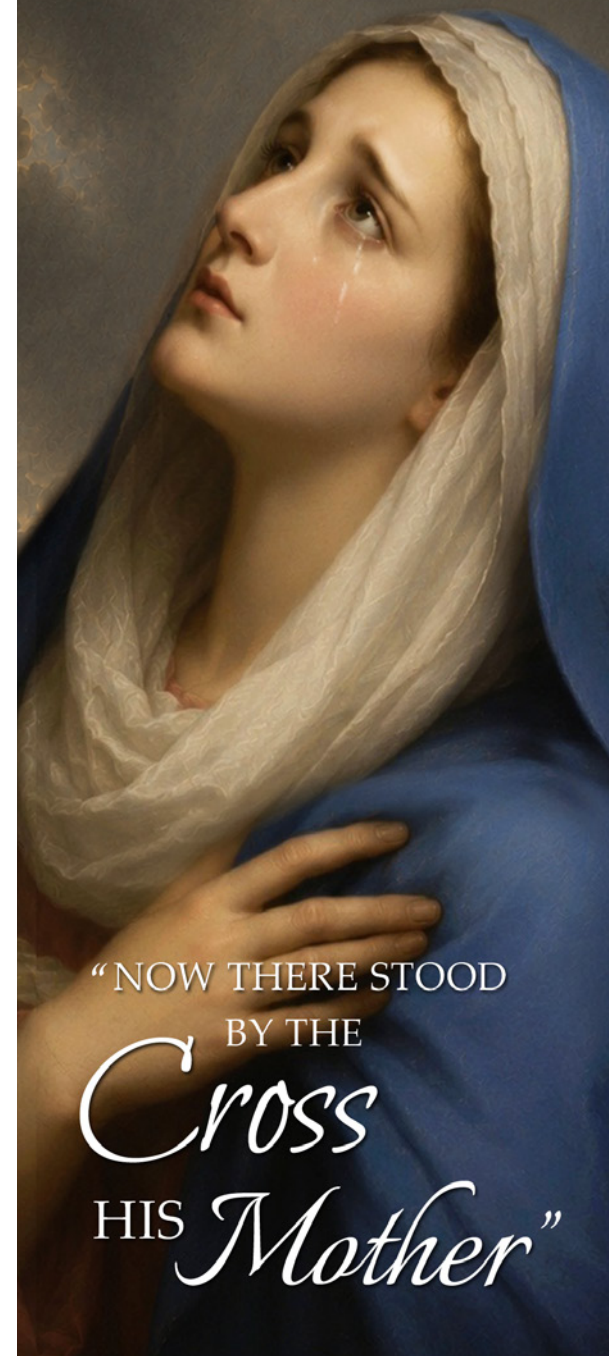

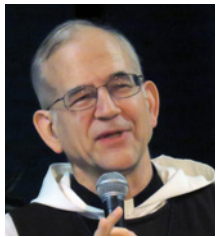
Most Rev. Mark A. Pivarunas, CMRI, was consecrated in 1991 by the late Bishop Moises Carmona. He is the superior general of the Congregation of Mary Immaculate Queen, pastor of Mary Immaculate Church in Omaha, rector of Mater Dei Seminary, and principal of Mater Dei Academy. His Excellency also founded the Congregation of Sisters of the Mother of God to assist him in his work for souls. He is a regular speaker at our annual Fatima Conference, discussing current affairs of the Church in these times of apostasy.



Most Rev. Michael Mary Sim, FSSR: Originally from New Zealand, Bishop Michael Mary Sim, FSSR, is the founder of the Transalpine Redemptorist Community. Based in Papa Stronsay, Scotland, these religious are “devoted to the Traditional Latin Mass and living according to the traditional Redemptorist spirit of St. Alphonsus Liguori.” Last October the community published an Open Letter in which they repudiated the heresies of Vatican II and the Conciliar Church. Then, on May 2 of this year, the community published a document entitled “The Dogma to Steer By,” in which they clearly laid out the case for sede-vacantism. Bishop Michael Mary was recently consecrated by Bishop Pierre Roy on July 25 of this year.



Rev. Fr. Casimir Puskorius, CMRI: Ordained by Bishop George Musey in 1986, Fr. Casimir served in several parishes before becoming pastor at Mount St. Michael, our largest parish, in 2001. In addition to his many duties as pastor, Father teaches in St. Michael's Academy. he is an accomplished pianist and enjoys playing the organ for various ceremonies, sometimes also joining with the choir to sing when he is not himself offering the Mass. Father is a regular speaker at the annual Fatima Conference.



Rev. Fr. Benedict Hughes, CMRI: Over the years as a priest and religious, Fr. Benedict has spent his life in various works in the service of Our Lady, particularly in the field of education. Having taught for some years in the major seminary as well as in St. Michael's Academy here at the Mount, he eventually began the minor seminary in 1999. Father is currently the pastor of Mary Immaculate Queen Church and rector of both St. Joseph Minor Seminary and St. Louis Marie de Montfort Seminary for religious in nearby Rathdrum, Idaho. He is also the editor of *The Reign of Mary*, CMRI's official magazine.

Rev. Fr. Dominic Radecki, CMRI, celebrates his 50th anniversary of First Vows this year. He has been pastor of Queen of Angels Church in Santa Clarita, California for 38 years and also serves at Immaculate Heart of Mary Church in Rosamond. Father has co-authored five books with his twin brother, Fr. Francisco, and written *True Devotion to Mary Simply Explained*. He also writes articles on the spiritual life for *The Reign of Mary* and is Director of the Confraternity of Mary Immaculate Queen and General Oeconomist.



Marie also travels regularly to provide Mass at the missions in Boise and Lewiston, Idaho.

Rev. Fr. Philip M. Davis, CMRI, was ordained by His Excellency on May 3, 2018. After some time in Omaha and Minnesota, and then assisting Fr. Benedict at Mary Immaculate Queen Parish at the City of Mary in Rathdrum, he was assigned two years ago to be assistant pastor here at Mount St. Michael, where he also teaches in the high school. Fr. Rev. Fr. Francisco Radecki, CMRI, celebrates the 50th anniversary of his First Vows this year. He was pastor of Sacred Heart Parish in Akron, Ohio, for five years and has served St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Wayne, Michigan for 33 years. Father has co-authored five books with his twin, Fr. Dominic, and written ten others, including catechisms, prayer books, Latin books, and a history book. He has also written many pamphlets on the Catholic Faith and writes periodically for *The Reign of Mary*.



Rev. Fr. M. Brendan Hughes, CMRI: After his ordination in 1989 by Bishop McKenna, Father assisted at various parishes and taught at Mater Dei Seminary until 1992, when he founded Immaculate Conception Parish in St. Cloud, Minnesota, where he served as pastor for 25 years. After serving as pastor of St. Michael's Chapel in Glenmont, New York, for the past 5 years, he moved this summer to the City of Mary, where he teaches in our major seminary for religious and also in the parish school.



Rev. Fr. Martin M. Sentman, CMRI: Since his ordination on April 29, 2025, Fr. Martin Marie has resided at the City of Mary, where he teaches in the seminary and parish school. In addition to assisting in the parish there, he also travels regularly on mission, principally to Canada, where he serves Mass centers in Alberta and Saskatchewan. He will deliver one of the sermons during our day of recollection on Saturday.



Rev. Fr. Carlos Zepeda was ordained to the priesthood on December 12, 2020. Since then, he has served as a pastor in missions in Oklahoma and South Dakota, as well as at Our Lady of the Snows in Denver. He began his religious life at a Carmelite monastery in Mexico in 2008 and, after eight years, transferred to the seminary in Omaha in 2016. In 2021, he founded the Catholic Wire podcast, which has since expanded to include a publishing store and other media endeavors. Fr. Zepeda currently resides in Georgia, where he is helping establish a community of Carmelite Sisters.

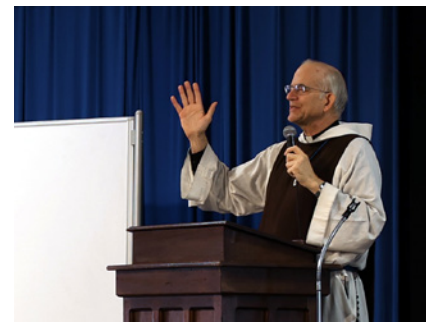
